Dear Families,

Please stay up to date by reading both school and classroom DOJO messages.

Helpful reminders for our online students:

*Thank you so much for your patience and positivity as we work through a variety of technical difficulties. Please know that these issues are due to large problems with outside internet issues, and not teacher or school errors.

*Please remember that it is required for students to check in with their teachers first thing in the morning, and then in the afternoon so that attendance can be taken. Failure to check in with the teacher in the morning will result in an absence, and if they are present in the morning but do not check in with the teacher in the afternoon, it will be marked as an early checkout.

*If your child has an appointment, please continue to provide us with a note so that it can continue to be an excused absence.

*Please continue to follow the schedule/lesson plan that your child's teacher has provided to you so that you know when to be online and when to work independently offline. It also provides you with information of what they will be working on each day so in case of a technical glitch, you can continue to work in your workbooks.

*Please make sure that your child is dressed in their school uniform, online, and ready to learn by 7:45.

*Please remember that cameras are being used for online learning, and that all students in a group can hear and see what is going on, so please be mindful of adult language and dress.

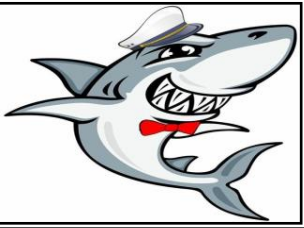
